9. DETAILS OF TEACHERS TRAINING: -

Two Days Teachers Training on 'Multi Skill Foundation Course' in Offline mode" at Delhi: -

A two-day teachers' training on Skill course "Multi skill Foundation Course" was organised on 17th and 18th October 2023 by Department of Skill Education (Delhi HQ) at Government Sarvodaya Boys Sr. Sec. School, Delhi. Mr. Sagar Mistri (TGT-Science) attended the program.

Teachers' Training Phase-1: -

A nine days Teachers' training program was conducted at school from 12th June to 20th June, 2023. It was conducted as per the guidelines issued by Sri Sathya Sai National Council for schools. Teachers attended the workshop in two different batches. Batch 'A' had 24 teacher and Batch 'B' 20 teachers. The resource persons were Mr. B. B. Gupta from Chandigarh, Mrs. Padmaja Bhonsle from Pune, Mrs. Mamta Saisundaram and Mr. Jagannath Karmakar from Karnataka. Different topics were covered in nine days. The program started with Omkaram, Veda chanting and Bhajans followed by welcome of guests. Course instructions were given by Principal. Everyday there were two sessions where different videos were shown and activities were conducted. On the last day each one shared their experiences and learning from the 9 days programme and assignments were also given that need to be completed till next phase, which shall be conducted in June 2024.

Mrs. Archana Bhadoriya (PGT-Biology) and Mr. Nagendra singh Tomar (PGT- Chemistry) attended the training. The resource persons were Ms. Smitha Anandan and Mr. Alok Virmani from CBSE. It was an eye opening session which emphasized on self-awareness, self-management, self-motivation, relationship management and social awareness.

Workshop on Ethics and Integrity: -

A three-day workshop on "Ethics and Integrity" was conducted in school on 24th, 26th and 27th March 2024. The resource person was Dr. Giri Shankar (HR and Behavioural training expert) from Mumbai. Forty-two teachers attended the workshop.

The students played 3 matches. The quarter Final match was played with Shishukunj International School, Indore. The participants of the event were- Sabrina Khan

(VIII-A), Vakada Vishalakshi (VII-A), Suhaavi Gupta (VI-A) and Ivanshi Bandulia (VI-A). They were escorted by Miss. Preeti Gupta (PRT-Yoga).

CBSE West Zone Badminton Tournament: -

CBSE west zone badminton tournament was held at Raghuwanshi public school, Sendhwa from 16th October to 19th October 2023. Our students participated in under 14 boys' category in which there were 64 teams from Gujarat, Rajasthan and Madhya Pradesh. The school team reached in the last 16 teams but finally lost to SSSVV, Indore who finally were declared the champion of CBSE west Zone. The team members were- Brijesh Kumar, Adamya Singh, Devansh Saxena and Arjun Agarwal.

CBSE cluster meet: -

CBSE clusters 12th Athletics Meet was held from 28th October to 31st October,2023 at LNCT World school (M. P). Shourya Sati and Trinayanjoy Rajkonwar of class VIII participated in boys under 14 categories. They were escorted by Mr. Anoop Mishra (PGT-P. E). there were 64 school teams from all over Madhya Pradesh which participated in the event. Trinayanjoy competed in shot put event and qualified for the final with top 8 shot putter. He stood at 4th place. Total 64 athletes participated in this event. He also participated in 100 m race in the heats but not able to qualify for the final as he finished on 4th position. Shourya Sati competed in 200 m race in the heats and was not able to qualify for the final.

ANNUAL SPORTS DAY 2023-24: -

The Annual Games and Sports Day was celebrated on 29-31 January 2024 with great zeal and enthusiasm. On 29th January in all 6 minor games were planned and played by the students of classes I to III. On 30th January house-wise matches for 12 games were organised in 23 different categories, whereas on 31st January Athletic - 8 track & field events were conducted in 44 categories.

13. INNOVATIONS: -

Innovation, Design and Entrepreneurship Boot Camp at Bhopal: -

Ministry of Education's Innovation Cell along with AICTE and Wadhwani Foundation had organised this camp which was a hands-on intensive 5-day experiential learning program from 22 June to 26th June where teachers and students used multiple product design methodologies and inculcated design thinking concepts to get an action-based experience on entrepreneurship. This camp was organized at 5 places across India simultaneously at Bhubhaneswar, Chennai, Chandigarh, Guwahati and at IISER, Bhopal.

Our school had participated in this program at Indian Institute for Science and Education Research, Bhopal and two students Vivek Meena(XII C) and Pawan Dhakad (XII B) along with Mrs. Shikha Mathur (Innovation Ambassador) attended it.

Students and teachers from around 30 schools all over India along with Smart India Hackathon winners from various colleges had come for this program as well.

The program included the following topics: -

- 1. Design Thinking for entrepreneurs
- 2. Design thinking strategies
- 3. Product Design and Engineering
- 4. Ergonomics in product design
- 5. Craft your value proposition
- 6. Build your start-ups- Competitive Advantage
- 7. Funding opportunities and Grants
- 8. International Markets
- 9. Delightful customer experience
- 10. Product design and Idea Pitching

Students and teachers were divided into a heterogeneous mix of teams and a step-by-step process from ideation to prototyping had to be done and Ideas had to be pitched in front of an expert and esteemed panel.

The idea behind this pilot camp was to initiate the ideas into something concrete and hands-on experience was given on entrepreneurship. It was to inspire school students into developing their own starts up ventures.

National Youth Ideathon 2023: -

It held as following-

Stage 1 - Idea Submission with prototype details - 6th October 2023 to 27th October 2023. Stage 2- Top 1000 List - 29th October 2023. Stage 3- Top 100 List -9th November 2023. Top 100 Online Interviews – 11th November 2023.

Total 75000 teams were participated in it. After Round 1, our team was amongst top 1000 teams. After Round 2, amongst top 100 teams. After Round 3 (final round), our team couldn't make into top 25. Mr Prankit Namdeo, PGT Computer Science was the mentor of the team. Team members were – 1. Aditi Parsedia (IX), 2. Mahesh Kumar (IX), 3. Devanshu Vastri (IX), 4. Virat Sahu (IX) and 5. Tanmay Kumrawat (IX). We have got Rs 5000 as consolation prize to the team and Rs 10000 to the mentor.

CBSE Science exhibition 2023-24: -

CBSE Delhi organized a Regional Science Exhibition at Sri Sathya Sai Vidya Vihar, Indore on 19th and 20th December 2023. The school also participated in it and sent two teams in two groups along with the mentors Mr. Pankaj Singh Sikarwar (PGT-Physics) and Mr. Devesh Saraswat (PRT).

The senior team prepared a model on sub-theme agriculture named smart crane lifted irrigation system IoT based. The team members were- Tanmay Kumrawat and Mahesh Kumar of class IX. Their model was highly appreciated. The Chief guest mentioned in his speech that this model can be used very well in practical form.

The Junior team had Vakada Sambasiva and Adamya Singh of class VII who built a flood protective house.

International Robotics Championship League-2023- ZONAL ROUND: -

Two teams, one junior and one senior comprising of eight students participated in zonal round of IRC, organized in Emerald Heights School, Indore on 12th December 2023. Eight students escorted by two teachers, Mr. Devesh Saraswat and Mr. Jayesh Yadav participated in this competition. The teams could not get selected for the national round but had a learning experience of the robotics championship.

16. SMC DECISIONS (IMPORTANT): -

- 1. The impact of NEP implementation, the minimum age to admission to class ECCE Prep, ECCE1 and ECCE2 and class 1 stands revised by the Government and has already been implemented in KV. Our school shall comply with the norms but had to relax the norms to confirm with the State Govt. norms.
- 2. While discussing the installation of Smart Interactive Panels in the classrooms it was agreed that 10 Classes may be converted every year to ensure that all students get the benefit of the new technology. The additional expenditure in this head shall not probably impact the overall budget and the over expenditure in this head shall be considered by the Board.
