9. DETAILS OF TEACHERS TRAINING: -

Webinar- Phonics: -

There was a webinar for ECCE teachers on Phonics. It was conducted online (ZOOM platform) by Mrs Chandra Sahu, IPN Leadership Academy on 30/04/2024 from 11 AM to 12 PM. The focused matter was –‘four stages of learning- listening, speaking, reading and writing. English language learning is to be introduced to nursery students through phonics. Phonics to be introduced through stories and poems.’

Workshop on Holistic Report Card: -

An online workshop on "How to develop a 360 degree Holistic report card" was conducted by IPN Leadership Academy on 28th May, 2024. It was attended by Mr. Sagar Mistri (TGT- Science) and Dr. Mily Nautiyal (Counsellor). The resource person was Mrs. Roja Paul K. It was an interactive session with a good learning experience.

TEACHERS' TRAINING WORKSHOP (SSNCS) (PHASE I): -

Nine days workshop was organized in school from 11th to 19th June '24 for 11 teachers of the school. This Phase 01 workshop was conducted by SSSNCS (Sri Sathya Sai National Council for Schools). The Resource persons for the Phase 01 Workshop were Mr. Sagar Mistri and Mrs. Nandini Bakshi.

TEACHERS' TRAINING WORKSHOP (SSSNCS) (PHASE II): -

Online session on Anecdotal Records: -

Online teachers' training workshop: -

All teachers tried to make a question paper accordingly and their queries were solved by the resource person.

Another workshop was on 17th August, 2024 which was on Assessment in early years and the resource person was Mrs. Sunayana Gupta (International Tutor teacher training). She told about different domains of development and how a teacher can assess a child in all these domains by conducting different activities. She resolved all the queries raised by teachers.

Both the sessions were very interactive.

11. ENVIRONMENT EDUCATION: -

Narayan sewa (XII-Girls): -Girls of Class XII A and B performed Narayan sewa on 30th June 2024 along with principal, Mr. Brijesh Gupta, Mrs. Anitha Biju, Mrs. Archana Bhadoria and Mrs. Pratima Srivastava. These girls were first introduced with the medicinal plants at the Herbal Garden of the school by Principal. Sir explained them about different plants and their medicinal and other uses. After that all the girls did plantation. All girls were divided in groups of four and each group has to plant 10 saplings of Mango, Neem, Jack fruit, Moringa and Gulmohar. In all they planted 85 saplings. They also filled bags for plantation with soil and manure.

Narayan Sewa (Class XII-Boys): -

On July 7th, 2024, students gathered on the school premises for our Narayan Seva initiative. The event began with an informative session led by our Principal, who discussed about various plants present on our campus, such as mint, ashwagandha, and oregano, etc. He also provided insights into the vermicomposting system in our school and explained its functioning. Following this, bags of soil and compost were prepared for planting the saplings that had been procured from a nursery. Each student participated in planting seven saplings, including species like Neem and *Peltophorum* and various other species. After planting, it was ensured that the saplings were well watered. The class teachers and the Principal also took part in the

activity by planting some saplings. The primary objective of planting these saplings on campus is to closely monitor their growth and nourishment. Once the plants are strong and healthy enough to thrive independently, they will be relocated to various other locations.

Narayan Sewa (Class XII-Girls): -

Girls of Class XII performed Narayan seva on 30th June 2024. The girls were first introduced with the medicinal plants of our Herbal Garden by Principal. Sir explained to them about different plants and their medicinal and other uses. All girls were divided in groups of four and each group planted 10 saplings of Mango, Neem, Jack fruit, Moringa and Gulmohar. In all they planted 85 saplings. They also filled bags for plantation with soil and manure. They promised that they will take care of the plants they grew and will monitor them regularly.

Narayan Seva Class XI (Boys): -

Boys of Class XI A and B performed Narayan seva on 17 July 2024. These boys, after reporting in the school were first introduced with the medicinal plants of our Herbal Garden by Principal. Sir explained them about different plants and their medicinal and other uses. After that all the boys did plantation. They were divided in groups of two and each group has to plant 12 saplings of Mango, Neem, Kathal, Jamun, Gauva and Sahtuat. In all they planted 120 saplings. They also filled bags for plantation with soil and manure. All were very happy.

Narayan Sewa Class XI (Girls): -

The Narayan Sewa of class XI girls was done on 17 July, 2024 . For the Sewa, a total collection of ₹5400 was contributed by the girls of XI-A and B.

In all 18 girls were present on the Sewa day. They were shown the different types of herbs, 26 fruit and several vegetable plants in the school campus by Principal and the class teachers. He also explained the students the process of making manure from the leaves that fall from the trees in the school premises in the Compost Pit. The same manure is being used in the school's herbal and vegetable gardens. They learnt how to transfer plants from smaller grow bags to bigger grow bags without disturbing the plants. Later, each girl student planted 5 plants, each of different categories like mango, jack fruit, neem, mulberry guava and Gulmohar. Students were told about the uses of different types of plants and herbs and how it is used in daily life and in medicines.

The participants engaged in planting saplings across designated spaces, They learned proper planting techniques, such as preparing the soil, placing the saplings, and ensuring adequate spacing between them.

The planting activity, helped the girls to know the importance of trees in maintaining ecological balance, improving air quality. The participants also committed to take care of the newly planted trees by ensuring regular watering and monitoring their growth. The event fostered a sense of responsibility and community spirit among the participants. The girls gained valuable knowledge about environmental conservation and practical skills in gardening and tree care.

This community service event not only contributed to environmental conservation but also empowered the young participants with a sense of purpose and responsibility toward their surroundings.

Painting Competition by GAIL: -

On the occasion of "Swachta Pakhwada," GAIL VIJAIPUR organized a vibrant painting competition on 11th July aimed at promoting cleanliness and hygiene. The event saw a tremendous response, with 450 students participating enthusiastically.

Narayan Sewa (Class X-Girls): -

The girls of Class X performed Narayan Seva on 3rd August 2024. After bhajans, the girls along with the Principal, class teachers and subject teachers went to the school's Ecological park. There sir showed different types of medicinal, fruit, and spice plants. After this, instructions were given on how the plantation should be done. Each girl along with their class teachers Mrs. Hema Mishra and Mrs. Snehal Shiralkar planted three saplings, resulting in a total of 45 plants being planted. The girls also took a pledge to take care of the plants. Overall, the Narayan Seva was performed very well, and the girls learned about the importance of plants and how they benefit us in nature.

Art integrated experiential learning (IX-A): -

Experiential learning for class IX A was conducted on 29th August 2024. The topic was 'Agriculture'. The experiential learning was an art integrated learning of Science with mathematics, Social science and languages. First day began with silent sitting followed by selection of topic with mutual discussion. On the second day Radiant thinking and mind mapping was done. During this step student suggested 231 words related to the topic "Agriculture" and then with a comprehensive discussion and reasoning they categorized these words into five sub-topics. In this way the web chart was prepared. These Sub- topics were- Tools and technologies, Agricultural practices, Irrigation, Management and policies, Culture and festivals. The whole class was divided into these five sub groups to work on these fields. Students prepared working and non - working models, experiments, charts, quizzes, Video games, puzzles and food items of different festivals in India. The presentation included five techniques such as Silent sitting, meditation. Storytelling, group singing and role play. The Principal observed all the presentations and guided the students. All students participated with full enthusiasm and learned many things by fun and activities.

Art Integrated Experiential Learning (VI-B): -

The Art Integrated Experiential Learning of class VI B was conducted on 3rd September 2024. The topic chosen was "Varsha". During Radiant thinking the students came up with 150 words which were further categorized into 5 groups- Prakriti aur paryavaran, Khan-pan, Tyohar, Sanskriti, Jalsanrakshan.

Narayan Sewa Class (IX A & B- Boys): -

Total 25 boys from both sections reported at school at 8 o'clock and participated in the sapling plantation in the School's Biodiversity park on 8th September, 2024. They potted 50 plants such as Guava, amla etc at the allocated places under the guidance of the Principal.

12. SPORTS ACHIEVEMENTS: -

SPIC MACAY YOG SHIVIR 2024: -

From 17th June to 21st June our school participated with 13 students (2 girls and 11 boys) with Miss Preeti Gupta (PRT-PET) in YOG SHIVIR organized by SPIC MACAY. The participants were Dhruv Kuswaha (VIII A), Dhawal Bhushan Kulkarni (X B), Hriday Shiralkar (VI A), Abhiraj Ranjit (VI C), Vishvjeet Patwa (VIII A), Gourik Mishra (X A), Yash Raghuvanshi (VIII A), Harsh Meena (VIII A), Mradul Dhakad (IX A), Adamyia Singh (VIII A), Krishna Pareek (IX A), Agrima Mishra (XI A) and Preeti Ahirwar (VIII A). In online yog shivir students participated from school campus in the morning from 8 am to 9 am. The participants were guided by yog guru Smt. Manju Jha. Participants learned many asana, joint exercises and pranayama very enthusiastically and happily.

Yoga day: -

Our school celebrated international Yoga day on 21st of June 2024. It started with three omkaram. In the beginning Principal delivered the speech on the importance of this day. He explained that in India we have 6 Philosophies of yogsutra written by Maharishi Patanjali. He also told how it was written by narrating a story behind this. Afterwards yog, asanas, pranayam and meditation was done by the students of classes 6th to 12th with energy and enthusiasm under the guidance of Miss Preeti Gupta (Yoga and PE teacher) and was coordinated by Mr Anoop Mishra (PGT-PE). Yog Shapath was also taken by all the students following Agrima Mishra, student of class 11th.

The program was concluded with shanti path.

KIA (Khelo India Assessment): –

On 13th July,2024, Khelo India assessment of classes II A and B was conducted and on 27th July,2024 it was conducted for classes I A and B. Three Assessments were done for all the students which were BMI (Body mass index), Plate tapping test for hand, eye and upper body coordination and Flamingo Balance test. It was conducted by Miss. Preeti Gupta (PRT-P. E) along with help of class teachers.

On 10th August 2024, Khelo India Assessment of classes III A and B was conducted. Three assessments were done for all students which were BMI (Body Mass Index), Plate tapping for hand, eye and upper body coordination and Flamingo Balance test. It was conducted by Miss Preeti Gupta (PRT-P.E.) along with the class teachers.

Khelo India Assessment for classes IV A and IV B was conducted on 6th September, 2024 by Miss Preeti Gupta (PRT-Yoga) along with the class teachers. Six assessments were done for all the students- Body Mass Index (Height and Weight), Flexibility test (For measuring muscle flexibility), Push ups (for measuring upper body capacity and endurance), Partial curl up (for measuring abdomen capacity and endurance), 600 meter run/walk (for measuring cardiovascular endurance) and 50-meter dash (for measuring velocity and speed).

Judo classes: -

BSE Cluster-XII Badminton Tournament: -

CBSE Cluster-XII Badminton Tournament was held at SAGE International school, Bhopal from

7th September to 10th September, 2024. In this tournament, four students- Adamyia Singh, Harsh Meena, Vakada Vishalakshi and Shree Haripriya of class VIII participated along with their mentors Mr. Anoop Mishra and Miss Preeti Gupta. Adamyia won the first round of singles played against Jindatta institute of education, Ujjain by 2-0. The boys also won the doubles first round by 15-0 and 15-09. They could not make it to the finals.

Interschool Kho-Kho competition: -

The school participated in Interschool Kho-Kho competition on 27th November, 2024 at Gurukul Higher secondary school, Guna. Around 12 schools participated in the event. The students were passionate about helping people and nature through their robotics solution. Their project was "Smart Surveillance using AI based drones" in which they proposed a hardware solution that can track and stream the video of specific circumstances and then transfer the data to the involved parties.
